Chris Dieter, Course Superintendent:

I hope everyone had a good Thanksgiving and enjoying many leftovers. We were definitely blessed with good golfing weather for an extended period.

This has been an even busier month than October. We started with the USDA coming to treat for adult lanternfly. Some of you may be already aware of this invasive bug species, if not, here is the USDA link to check out: fhttps://www.aphis.usda.gov/aphis/resources/pests-diseases/hungry-pests/the-threat/spotted-lanternfly/spotted-lanternfly. (See Right: Spotted Lanternflies on a tree at Rock Harbor) The USDA had a team come in and spray several areas of trees on the course, at no cost to us. They will be back this winter to scrape and collect egg masses from the trees. The team will then return in the spring to spray the juveniles after they hatch. They do not do so much damage to our trees as they do to some of the crops or our personal gardens.


We planted 60 trees this month. Varieties were selected to add some new color to several areas. Trees were also placed to provide protection between holes. In the four seasons I have been here, we have cut almost 300 trees off the course, so planting 60 or more becomes necessary to maintain the look and challenge we all love at Rock Harbor.



Our most recent bunker project has been Rock #12. For those of you who have not seen it yet may be pleasantly surprised to see the changes we made to the back of the green and back bunker. (See below: Rock #12 Bunker/ Green). It will definitely play different.
