This time of year, it is remarkably busy, so stay tuned to your email for on-going information and updates. We are implementing a new text messaging system you may opt to participate in for details on frost delays, course conditions, closures, and F & B info. Always try to remember to check the member bulletin boards on the front porch as well, this is where you can sign up for tournaments and weekly league play and obtain other useful and fun information.

Daylight Saving Time begins in 2021 on Sunday, March 14, when clocks will "Spring Forward" one hour and we lose an hour of sleep overnight. Though it has been staying light out a little later each day since the winter solstice on Dec. 21, the big change will occur at 2 a.m. on March 14 with the shift to Daylight Savings Time. The driving range will close 1 hour before sunset, and all carts must be in 30 minutes prior to sunset. This gives our staff time to pick the range while still light out for balls to stock and sell the next day and clean the carts before dark. These times will NOT CHANGE until the Fall. There may be unexpected maintenance that requires us to close the range, or if the range is too soggy, we may have to do so then as well. Your cooperation is very much appreciated, and while you may forget what time to be in, a Ranger will be happy to remind you to return to the Pro Shop. As always, I am open to your coaching, suggestions and comments. I am grateful to have you all as members! Again, think warm thoughts and I look forward to seeing you soon!


I look forward to this wonderful 2021 golf season. Daylight savings will occur March 14th with the change in time we will have adjusted hours for the Golf Course and Driving Range.
