Taylor's Tip:

What makes a professional caddie special? Ability to judge the wind! Professional caddies are amateur meteorologist.

Amateur golfer's underestimate the wind. The wind has the potential to affect every golf shot from a 300-yard drive to a three-foot putt. The best thing to do is to check nearby trees to see what the wind is doing higher up. Smaller branches will begin to move when the wind reaches 15 mph. Winds of 25 mph will move large branches. Of course, when you can see the green, you can check the flag on the pin. If it is extended, wind speeds are probably at least 10 mph. It is much easier to "play the wind." To hit a shot that fights against the wind limits the outcome of the quality of the shot.
