The Green

Sometimes I think there is something about a golf ball that destroys one's ability to think. I believe the best strategy in a wartime situation is bomb a country with golf balls then just walk in and take over. But seriously, folks, sometimes there seems to be a real lack of common sense out on the course.

Over the years, I have heard the following statements from golfers:


"I never make a divot." "I never leave a ball mark." "I always fix my divots, that's why I don't go to Sand & Suds." "I fix all my ball marks, why should I fix someone else's?"

I have learned there are no absolutes in life. Words like NEVER and ALL do not apply in golf, except for "I never land in the fairway" or "I always miss my putts".



When we have heavy rains, or Cart Path Only status, pay attention to low areas. Do not pass the other carts in your group in low areas. At Rock #5, near #6 Tees, everyone likes to pass in the low, wet swale, pictured left. Rock #8 is another hole that people damage while passing each other.

Boulder #9 gets frequent damage, pictured right. There are several places where people will drive around a puddle on the cart path and do damage in the turf on either side off said cart path, pictured left.



Over the past few years, we have gotten too many divots taken out of greens, a swing in frustration and anger over a missed putt goes too far or accidentally too deep. I recommend breaking your putter rather than damaging the green. The Pro Shop will sell you a new one that works better. Why take shots/divots off of Boulder #6, #7, #12 and Rock #13 when the rule is free drop off the green, no closer to the hole (including the collar)? It is interesting that this damage, pictured right, stops when the word gets out that I have cameras out.

Recently, we've removed our fifth cart out of a pond in the last seven years, pictured below. Let's be thankful that none of these had injuries. Remember, you will be charged for damages to carts, same as a rental car. These charges include our time retrieving the cart.



Remember, all these things cost maintenance money, which eventually will raise dues, greens fees, and cart fees. Let's all be careful, have good golf etiquette, and have fun.
