

# The Green




Chris Dieter, Course Superintendent:

Rain, rain, go away, all the golfers want to play. Watch what we wish for; I'd rather have a little less rain or rain only at night—no draughts this year please. Most of the past month has been trying to keep up with mowing our course. We have really had a growth spurt this spring, combined with wet weather; it becomes a challenge of mowing without doing damage to a wet course. Our team is always pushing to get the course in the best shape for our players.

We did get the opportunity to finish a couple of bunkers. At the practice



green, we built a berm above the bunker to keep the parking lot from washing the bunker out. On Rock 3, we replaced the sand, that was full of gravel, with new sand. The wet weather has held us up slightly with finishing the bunker on Boulder 13, the end is near I promise. On Boulder 13, we also had an irrigation leak in a tricky spot to add to our excitement, pictured left and right.
