FFA Blue Jacket Outing—May 9th



Technology is all around us, in our cars, appliances, cell phones—of course, we are going to have it on our golf courses! We see apps for cell phones, range finders, smart watches all of the time. At Rock Harbor Golf Maintenance, we have technology with our irrigation system, our chemical sprayer, moisture meters, and even the diagnostics we use in the repair shop.

Getting used to the changes using technology can sometimes present challenges (i.e. our new GPS systems on the golf carts). We have run into more issues than we could ever anticipate. The supplier of the cart system is currently working to fix the problems. Thank you all for your patience in this matter. In the meantime, remember you always need to obey the existing cart directional signs.

On a more exciting side of things, we recently had a demonstration of a robotic mower. This mower will be working on the fairways of Rock #10 and



Boulder #18, pictured left, as well as some rough areas, pictured down. The robotic mowers seem to be the wave of the future. A great benefit of these mowers is the minimal
