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

We have been running some lunch specials and we currently have chili. I've even made a soup and, as long as the weather is seasonal and not hot, I'll keep on soups. We are still having



I would like to hit on a more personal note this month, since I am getting a lot of questions on this matter. Yes, I had a cardiac event and yes, I am ok. I am having testing done to figure out what is going on. In this testing, however, I had an echocardiogram, pictured left. The doctor says this shows that ball marks, divots, and golf carts are a significant factor to my condition! So, while I appreciate everyone's concern, please fix your ball marks and divots, and keep your golf carts where they are supposed to be.



So, what's happening on the golf course? This past month we have spent quite

a bit of time fixing the drainage from Rock #14 waste bunker, pictured right. The drainage from this waste bunker is a 6-inch pipe over 400 feet long and was full of limestone sand and other debris,



this is why it is full of water and mud after every rain, pictured left. When it is finished it will drain and be playable. Thank you for everyone's suggestions of filling in this area with grass, at this time that idea has been rejected by the architectural committee.



You may have noticed quite a bit of animal digging activity on the course, this is from skunks. The skunks however are not the real problem. The problem starts with grubs in the ground which the skunks dig up and eat. The grubs are also a problem as they eat the roots off of the grass plants. We are currently (when the weather permits) spraying for the grubs and over-seeding the scratched-up areas on the course. We are also seeding any areas which we lost turf due to the drought this summer, pictured right. As always feel free to stop me for questions and criticisms.
